Linked to Angels and Satan

- For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, <u>Rom 8:38-39</u>
- For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places 16 taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. Eph <u>6:12</u>

Manifold

- I. much-variegated; marked with a great variety of colors: 2. manifold... manifesting itself in a great variety of forms..." (Thayer, p. 529; 4182).
- Like a Rainbow or Diamond break down light. Can't see full variety without them.

Church - God's Creative Genius

- The church reveals God's manifold Wisdom
- But although the Holy Spirit revealed it to us
- The principalities and powers in heaven see it.
- God planned it in eternity.
- Centerpiece of His eternal purpose.
- To show principalities and powers in heavenly places His manifold Wisdom.
- They see the church in its fullest sense.
- They see in the church things far more complex and amazing than anything in the material creation

God gave Jesus the Plans

- Jesus came to build His church.
- Mt 16:16-18
- He chose and prepared apostles
- He prepared people for three years.
- He suffered and died to purchase the church. Acts 20:28
- He sent the Holy Spirit to completely reveal the plans. Jn 14:26; 16:13-14

Holy Spirit Revealed

- The plans and blueprints of the church are recorded in Scripture.
- When we take those plans and carefully pattern our lives after those plans, God's manifold wisdom shines again.


This is the Reason why
