The roots of the tree gives it both stability and sustenance.




Rooted in Love

As a Tree (Roots) / Building (Foundation)

- Agape love is the key to unlock the door that leads to both knowledge and ability to understand the love of Christ. Without it we are nothing!
- Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. 2 And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. 3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing. 1Cor 13:1-8

To Know the Love of Christ

Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Have this mind in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. 8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9 For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, Phil. 2:3-8

The Wording is Important

- may be able to comprehend with all the saints
- what is the width and length and depth and height
- to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge;
- It is a progression.
- First, rooted and grounded in love we open the door of possibility because without *agape-love it is impossible!*
- Second, we must become aware of how vast and complex this love it.
- It has width, length, depth and height.
- How can we comprehend how the one who created us with omnipotent power and wisdom left heaven, took a human body and died for us?
