- Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Mt 7:21
- whoever does not bear his cross and forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple. Lk. 14:26-33
- I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified. I Cor. 9:24-27
- conduct yourselves throughout the time of your stay here in fear; <u>1Pet. 1:14-17</u>
- Eye, hand or foot cause stumble cut it off, pluck it out

Come unto me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and you shall find rest unto your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. 
Balance Between Rebuke and Exhort Balancing God's Grace and God's Wrath




The True Balance of Grace


A Life of Ease and Sloth

- Blessed <u>ARE</u> the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 4 Blessed <u>ARE</u> the mourning ones, For they shall be comforted. Mt 5:3-4
- Even after Grace God expects humility / concern
- "But on this one will I look: On him who is poor and of a contrite spirit, And who trembles at My word." Isa 66:2
- God's grace doesn't remove our own unworthiness
- The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit. Ps 34:18-19

The True Balance of Grace

- "Therefore you, O son of man, say to the children of your people: 'The righteousness of the righteous man shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression; as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall because of it in the day that he turns from his wickedness; nor shall the righteous be able to live because of his righteousness in the day that he sins.' Ezek. 33:12-13
- If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1Jn 1:9-10

The True Balance: At our Worst

- For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. 7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. 9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Rom 5:6-11
- Yet, even after all these years of effort and toil, we still have so far to go. We will never reach it.
- Yet because we are justified, reconciled we are saved
