Bonus #3. What happened in Leviticus 10:1-3? Do you see a potential connection with verse 9? What does this say about the nature of God (Acts 5:1-11)?

Bonus #4. Harmonize the following scriptures on the topic of what Christians can eat: Gen. 1:29; Gen. 9:2-4; Lev 11; Acts 10:9-16; Acts 15:29; Rom. 14:13-15, 23; 1 Cor. 8.

Bonus #5. What was leprosy (Lev. 13-14)? Name three famous lepers in the Bible.

Bonus #6. What were "familiar spirits" (Lev. 20:6, 27)? What was the penalty for using one? Name a famous person in the Bible who did and tell what happened. Name some occult practices today. Should Christians get involved in them?

Bonus #7. According to Jesus, what were the two greatest commandments of the Law? Why would this be the case? Are they applicable today? Why?
