 - e) Can you find any parallels between what happened to Jonah and Jesus Christ? (Hint: use your OT-NT cross-reference.)
- D. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Amos. In addition:
 - e) What can you find out about different kinds of idolatry and false gods in the Bible? In what ways is idolatry a problem in America today?
- E. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Hosea. In addition:
 - e) The names of Bible characters generally have an underlying meaning (unlike many modern names). What is significant about the names of Hosea's children?
- F. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Isaiah. In addition:
 - e) List the parallels between the "Suffering Servant" of Isaiah 53 and Jesus Christ.
- G. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Micah. In addition:
 - e) Can you find a Messianic prophecy in Micah? (Hint: use your OT-NT cross-reference.)
