 - f) How was the rebuilding of the temple resumed?

- C. Answer the same a) thru d) questions for the book of Zechariah. In addition,
 - e) According to chapter 7:1-6, the Jews in captivity fasted & mourned, but God still didn't approve of it.
 - a. List three examples of religious things done today that God doesn't approve of.
 - b. List two examples of doing what God approves of, but doing it with an attitude that God does not approve of.
