

# Keep The Commandments of the Lord

- Beginning in the Garden of Eden and continuing through the Patriarchal, Mosaic and Christian eons and dispensations, one thing has never changed.
- *12 "And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, 13 and to keep the commandments of the Lord and His statutes which I command you today for your good?  
Deut 10:12-14*

# Attitude Toward God's Commands

- *And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the Lord your God and serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul,” Deut 11:1*
- *“Therefore you shall love the Lord your God, and keep His charge, His statutes, His judgments, and His commandments always. Deut 11:1*
- *“And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the Lord your God and serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul,” Deut 11:13;*

# Noah's Attitude

- *Thus Noah did; according to all that God commanded him, so he did. Gen 6:22*
- *And Noah did according to all that the Lord commanded him. Gen 7:5-6*
- *Abraham's Attitude*
- *"You are the Lord God, Who chose Abram, And brought him out of Ur of the Chaldeans, And gave him the name Abraham; 8 **You found his heart faithful before You,** And made a covenant with him Neh 9:7-8*

# Hezekiah was Faithful –

- *Thus Hezekiah did throughout all Judah, and he **did what was good and right and true before the Lord his God.** 21 And in every work that he began in the service of the house of God, in the law and in the commandment, to seek his God, he did it with all his heart. So he prospered. 32 After these deeds of faithfulness, Sennacherib king of Assyria came. 2Chr 31:20-21*

# Moses was Faithful as was Jesus

- *Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus,*
- *2 who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was faithful in all His house. Heb 3:1-2*
- *Thus Moses did; according to all that the Lord had commanded him, so he did. Ex 40:16*

# Love = Keeping Commands

- The true essence of our love, faith and respect is seen in our submission, obedience and desire to fully obey.
- *21 If you love Me, keep My commandments.*
- *15 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me.*
- *10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.*
- *John 14:15 , 21; 15:10*
- It is imperative that we understand the connection between our love and obedience.

# Jesus Loved and Did God's Will

- *For it is impossible that the blood of bulls and goats should take away sins. 5 Therefore, when coming into the world, He said: “Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure.” 7 Then I said, “**Behold, I have come** — In the volume of the book it is written of Me — **To do Your will, O God.**” Heb. 10:5-7*

# Jesus Came to do God's Will

- *My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work 4:31-35*
- *I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me. Jn 5:30*
- *For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. Jn 6:37-39*

# Two Wills - David & Saul

- *And Samuel said to Saul, You have done foolishly. You have not kept the commandment of the Lord your God, which He commanded you. For now the Lord would have established your kingdom over Israel forever. 14 But now your kingdom shall not continue. The Lord has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the Lord has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the Lord commanded you. 1Sam 13:13-14*

# The Will of God

- *"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but **he who does the will of My Father in heaven.** Mt 7:21-22*
- *If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. John 15:10*

# Wanting to Give God the Glory

- *If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. 1 Peter 4:11*

# Authority

- *Every word of God is pure; He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him. 6 Do not add to His words, Lest He rebuke you, and you be found a liar. Pr. 30:5-6*
- *7 Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. Josh 1:7-8*
